These have included projects like food relief and water filters to third-world countries, medical equipment to local businesses, and sending Bibles to mission partner churches around the world.

Being a part of these special opportunities to contribute financially provides a way to respond directly to missionary needs in lasting, meaningful ways while sharing the hope of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

# It's Decision Time

You are invited to become more deeply involved in Living Missionally at McGregor and to pray about how God would use you in 2025 in the work He has already begun around the world.



There are three essential components to participate in global missions at McGregor today:

## 1. GIVE

This year, McGregor is continuing the Global Missions Offering commitment, giving your family the opportunity to give generously beyond your regular offering towards the missionaries McGregor supports. The 2025 Global Missions Offering is a covenant between you and the Lord to support McGregor's Acts 1:8 Strategy. You may give one time in the commitment envelope and also continue giving toward your commitment throughout the year.

## 2. GO

Be a part of a short-term mission trip. MBC has teams departing throughout the year to destinations around the globe. Get more information on these mission projects at the Taste of the Nations Breakfast during GIC or call the Missions Office at (239) 790-0309.

## 3. PRAY

As followers of Jesus, we are all part of the task to fulfill the Great Commission. Paul writes, "All of you together are Christ's body, and each of you is part of it." (1 Corinthians 12:27) Jesus has commissioned us to be His heart, His hands, and His voice. Through prayer, McGregor has helped the cause of Christ all around the world for many years, yet billions remain lost, and time is running out for them. Let's pray more intentionally and give more sacrificially than ever before. Our church must take direct responsibility for helping reach the unengaged, unreached people groups that are challenging to get to. Since most unreached people groups likely are represented in the world's urban centers, we have unique challenges and opportunities to reach the world in the days ahead. What can you do, individually? Start by praying for the unreached peoples of the world; next, commit to praying for our mission trips, and finally, consistently lift up our missionary and ministry partners.



## CULTIVATING COMPASSION

Consider those around us locally that are in desperate need of hearing the Gospel of Jesus. This Gospel is going out to every nation, and you have the opportunity to participate in praying, giving, and going on a mission trip this year.
